Requirement for Presentation Submission and Template of Presentation Abstract

Submission of Presentation

- 1. Novel & in-depth reports (haven't been presented/published in China or some new content/development required if published outside China)
- 2. Highlight innovations and actual or expected impacts
- 3. Case study or analysis of research results is advised
- 4. Practical solutions would be also preferred
- 5. Presentations in both English and Chinese are highly recommended
- 6. Please provide your presentation by using PowerPoint97-2003 if possible, to avoid on-site compatibility issues, PPT of 16:9 ratio are required
- 7. It should be less than 1 minute if any sales promotion section in your speech
- 8. Organizing Committee suggests that your technical executive deliver the speech, which could better present your technology leadership image, and attract more high-level delegates from your target groups.

Abstract Template for Reference EN and CN abstracts are required for reviewing and participation inviting

- 1. Presentation title
- 2. Author
- 3. Key words (about 5 key words)
- 4. Research and/or Engineering Questions/objectives or Methodology
- 5. Main technical, economic and/or practical points
- 6. Aspects of novel, innovative and unique
- 7. Case study or analysis of research results (It is better to have data)
- 8. Conclusion
- 9. Attach 3 -4 key points of presentation

- * Please pay attention to the content and format of the presentation abstract template, **particularly the novelty and depth of your presentation**, when preparing your abstract. A comprehensive abstract is very important for your speech to be accepted and will increase your chance of receiving a discount on speech sponsorship fee (the sponsorship application and abstract be submitted before February 10th).
- * TMC Committee will decide whether to accept the presentation mainly on the basis of the abstract review.
- * Organizing Committee will review the submitted presentation PPT to check the advertisement content and its consistency with the abstract.
